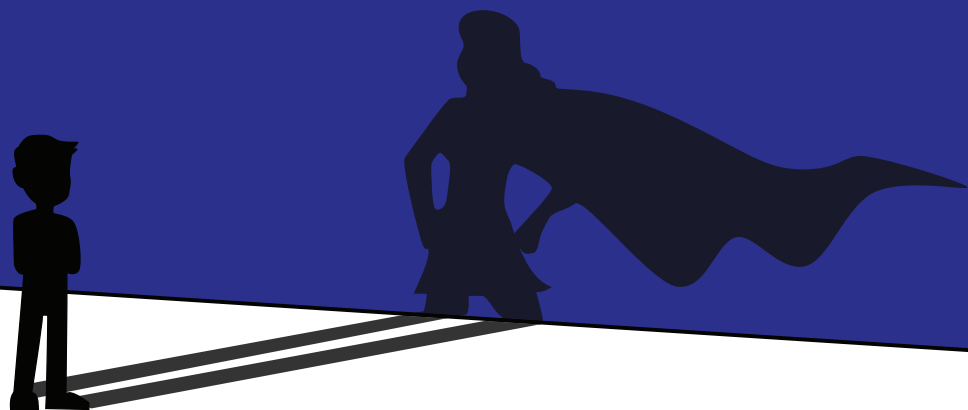


# The Adventures of **MISTER PERFECT** and Friends

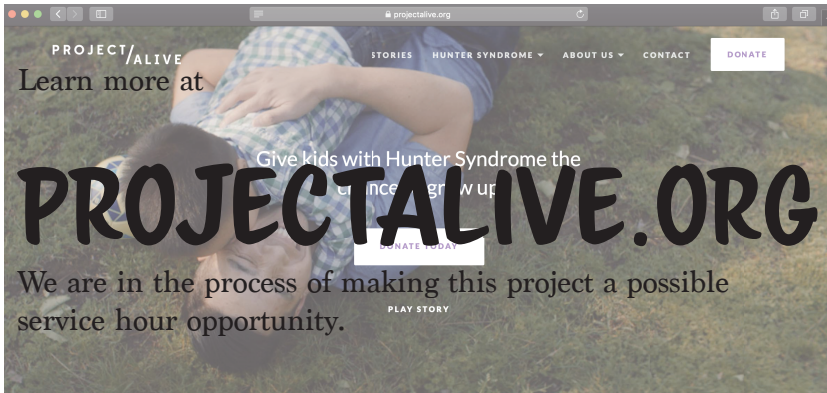

What can I say about TAMPAF? Well for starters, we don't even know if that's going to end up being the name by the end of this. But on a more serious note, I have hope. Now, do I think it'll be great? In all honesty, I can't say. That may sound pessimistic, but nobody can. Even professional writers and directors don't know how the film will end up, I can only hope that I can write the best I can, and that I can use my filmmaking experience to help in some way.

However, what I can say for certain is that the people working on it are passionate, and that they, including myself, will make it the best it can be. I can only hope that we actually make it and make it good, partly because it's really too late to turn back now, but partly because we've never done something of this size before, and how amazing it will be to see it through to the end. So far, we're only in pre-production and it has already been one of the craziest things that I've been apart of, from helping find equipment, to helping find sponsors, to writing a lot of this, I can safely say that this has been an incredible experience. One that has prepared me for the professional world, and one that will stay close to my heart forever.
